Following in that tradition, “National Lampoon’s Cattle Call” is a raunchy comedy about a group of friends who start a fake casting agency to meet women. The film is written and directed by Martin Guigui and produced by Josi Konski.

Aspiring actresses are encouraged to submit their headshots and resumes for a shot at an acting contract with Astrablu Media, producers of “National Lampoon’s Cattle Call” and a chance to appear in a future motion picture production.
